Rules of the Essay Competition

1. Subject:
Junior (Class V-VII) : Financial Literacy– a step towards social development

Senior (Class VIII - X) : Role of Banking in country's economic development'
(രാജ്യത്തിന്റെ സാമ്പത്തിക വികസനത്തിൽ ബാങ്കുകളുടെ പങ്ക്)
2. Language : English / Malayalam
3. Eligibility to participate : Students of Schools in Kerala. Children of the employees of Kerala Gramin Bank are not eligible to participate in the competition.
4. Stipulations regarding the Essay : The essay should not exceed 1000 words for junior and 1500 for senior categories respectively. The essay shall be neatly handwritten on one side of the paper only. Name, address or signature of the participant should not appear on essay sheets. Copying from internet is not allowed.
5. Procedure for sending the Essay : The participants have to fill up the entry form (given overleaf) and get it attested by the Head of the School with office seal. The Schools may collect all the essays received from their students and forward to:
